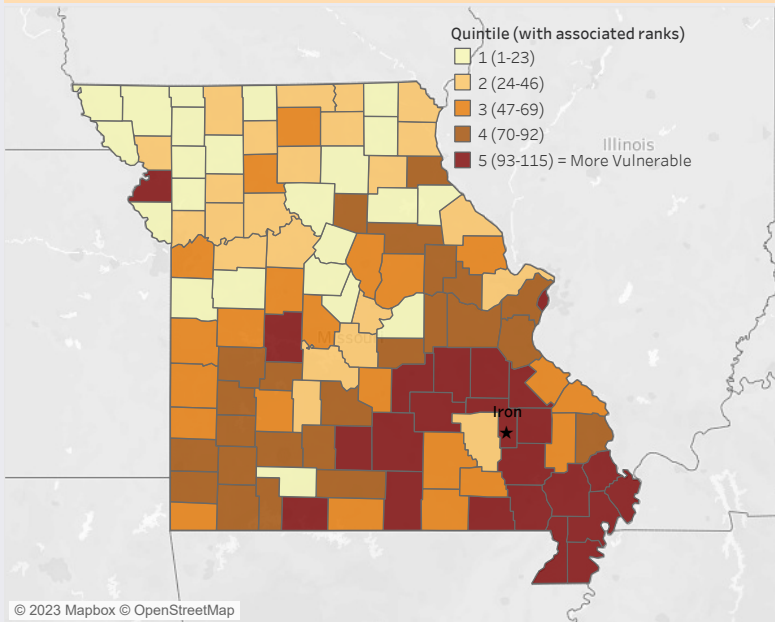
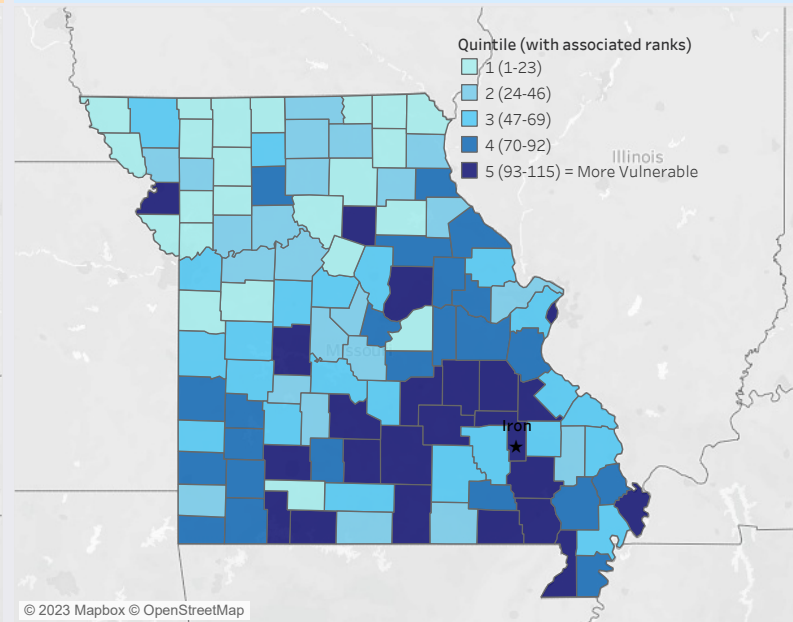


2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Iron County

Opioid Overdose



Bloodborne Infection



Iron County ranked in the 5th quintile (105th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 5th quintile (103rd) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment as well. In the opioid overdose assessment, Iron County's worst ranking was for the rate of opioid misuse ER visits. For the bloodborne infection assessment, its worst ranking was also for the rate of opioid misuse ER visits with the rate of HCV among ages 18 to 40 close behind. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and the county's median income was its worst ranking factor.
