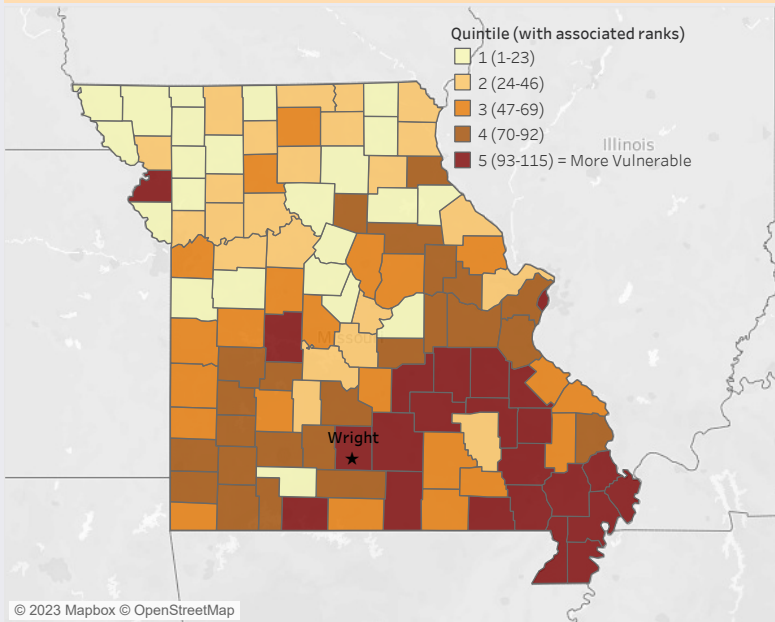
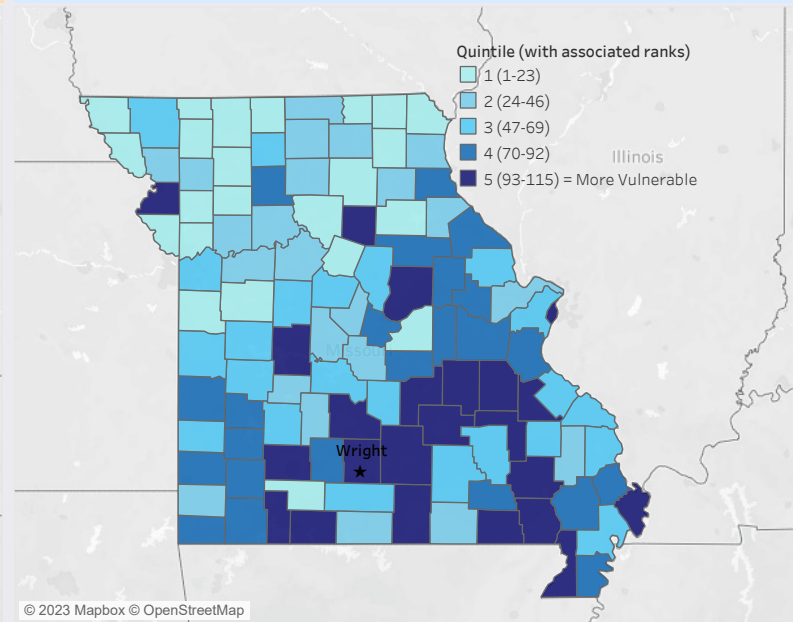


2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Wright County

Opioid Overdose



Bloodborne Infection



Wright County ranked in the 5th quintile (108th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and was in the 5th quintile (94th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment. In the opioid overdose assessment, Wright County ranked in the 5th quintile for the rate of drug related arrests and the rate of poor mental health days. For the bloodborne infection assessment, Wright County was ranked in the 5th quintile for the rate of Injection Drug Use (IDU) among Substance Use Disorder Treatment (SUDT) recipients and the rate of drug-related arrests. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and Wright County ranked in the 5th quintile for all 5 of the community factor indicators with its worst ranking being median income.
