Provisional Vital Statistics for August 2006

Live births increased in August as 7,411 Missouri babies were born compared with 7,025 one year earlier. Cumulative births also increased for the 8 and 12-month periods ending with August. For January-August, births increased by 2.3 percent.

Deaths decreased for all three time periods shown below. For January-August, deaths decreased by 1.5 percent.

The **Natural increase** in August was 3,233 (7,611 births minus 4,178 deaths). With births increasing and deaths decreasing, the natural increase rose by 11 percent for January-August.

Marriages decreased for all three time periods shown below. For January-August, marriages decreased by 2.6 percent.

Dissolutions of marriage decreased slightly in August, but increased for the 8-month period ending with August. For the 12 months ending with August, the marriage to divorce ratio decreased from 1.90 to 1.86.

Infant deaths decreased slightly for all three time periods shown below. For the 12-months ending with August, the infant death ratio decreased from 7.6 to 7.2 per 1,000 live births.
