Provisional Vital Statistics for January 2006

Live births increased in January as 6,835 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,425 one year earlier. The provisional 2005 live birth count of 78,500 is the state's highest since 1990.

Deaths decreased in January as 5,142 Missourians died compared with 5,433 in January 2005. Cumulative deaths for the 12 months ending with January also decreased.

The **Natural increase** in January was 1,693 (6,835 births minus 5,142 deaths). For the cumulative 12– month periods ending with January the natural increase rose for each of the past three years.

Marriages increased in January, but the provisional 2005 marriage rate of 7.0 per 1,000 population was the lowest ever recorded.

Dissolutions of marriage decreased in January and for the 12 months ending with January. The provisional 2005 divorce rate of 3.6 per 1,000 population was the lowest recorded since 1968.

Infant deaths increased in January as 63 Missouri infants died compared with 53 one year earlier. The provisional 2005 infant death rate of 7.5 per 1,000 population was the same as the 2004 final rate.
