## **Provisional Vital Statistics for May 2006**

**Live births** increased in May as 6,926 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,680 in May 2005. Births also increased for the cumulative fivementh period ending with May, from 32,322 in 2005 to 33,888 in 2006.

**Deaths** decreased in May as 5,154 Missourians died compared with 5,533 one year earlier. Cumulative deaths increased for the five months ending with May, but decreased for the 12 months ending with May.

The **Natural increase** in May was 1,772 (6,926 birth minus 5,154 deaths). This compares with 1,147 one year earlier.

**Marriages** decreased for all three time periods shown below.

**Dissolutions of marriage** increased for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with May, the marriage to divorce rate decreased from 1.90 to 1.79.

**Infant deaths** decreased in May but increased for the cumulative 5 and 12 month periods ending with May. For the 12 months ending with May, the infant death rate increased from 7.6 to 7.8 per 1,000 live births.
