Provisional Vital Statistics for August 2007

Live births decreased in August as 7,176 Missouri babies were born compared with 7,503 one year earlier. However, cumulative births for the 8– and 12– month periods ending with August both increased.

Deaths decreased for all three time periods shown below. For January-August, deaths decreased by 1.8 percent from 36,374 to 35,704.

The **Natural increase** in August was 3,045 (7,176 births minus 4,131 deaths). For the cumulative 8– and 12– month periods, the natural increase rose.

Marriages decreased for all three time periods shown below. For January-August, marriages decreased by 6.3 percent.

Dissolutions of marriage also decreased for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with August, the marriage to divorce ratio decreased from 1.84 to 1.75.

Infant deaths decreased in August as 42 Missouri infants died compared with 57 for August 2006. For January-August, the infant death rate decreased from 7.4 to 7.2 per 1,000 live births.
