## **Provisional Vital Statistics for March 2007**

**Live births** decreased in March as 6,764 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,948 one year earlier. Cumulative births decreased for January-March, but increased by 2.3 percent from 79,413 to 81,219 for the 12 months ending with March.

**Deaths** decreased in March as 4,699 Missourians died compared with 5,023 in March 2006. Cumulative deaths for the 3-and 12-month periods also both decreased.

The **Natural increase** in March was 2,065 (6,764 births minus 4,699 deaths). The natural increase rose for all three time periods shown below.

**Marriages** increased slightly in March, but decreased for January-March and the 12-months ending with March.

**Dissolutions of marriage** decreased for March and January-March, but increased for the 12 months ending with March. For this latter time period, the marriage to divorce ratio decreased from 1.90 to 1.83

**Infant deaths** decreased slightly in March as 45 Missouri babies died compared with 49 in March 2006. For the 12 months ending with March, the infant death rate remained the same, 7.4 per 1,000 live births.

Beginning with provisional July 2006 data numbers and rates are based on month of event rather than month of report.
