## Provisional Vital Statistics for November 2007

Live births decreased in November as 6,588 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,715 in November 2006. Cumulative births for the 11 - and $12-$ month periods ending with November both show slight increases.

Deaths decreased for all three time periods shown below. For January-November, deaths decreased by 2.4 percent from 49,738 to 48,542.

The Natural increase in November was 2,301 (6,588 births minus 4,287 deaths). For JanuaryNovember, the natural increase rose 6.4 percent from 24,772 to 26,359.

Marriages increased slightly for all three time periods shown below. For the 12 months ending with November, marriages increased by 0.9 percent from 40,043 to 40,410 .

Dissolutions of marriage show little change for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with November, the dissolution rate remained the same as the previous year, 3.8 per 1,000 population. The marriage to divorce ratio increased slightly from 1.80 to 1.81 for this time period.

Infant deaths decreased for all three time periods. For January-November, the infant death rate decreased from 7.5 to 7.3 per 1,000 live births.

* Rates for live births, deaths, natural increase, marriages and dissolutions are computed on the number per 1000 estimated population. The infant death rate is based on the number of infant deaths per 1000 live births. Beginning with provisional July 2006 data numbers and rates are based on month of event rather than month of report. This will result in a delay in reporting, but will more accurately reflect current trends.
