Provisional Vital Statistics for April 2008

Live births increased slightly in April as 6,522 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,466 one year earlier. Live births also increased slightly for the cumulative 4- and 12-month periods ending with April.

Deaths increased slightly in April, but increased by 9.2 percent for January-April from 18,938 to 20,671. For the 12 months ending with April, deaths increased by 2.5 percent.

The **Natural increase** for April was 1,984 (6,522 births minus 4,538 deaths). Because of the increase in deaths, the natural increase declined for the 4-and 12-month periods ending with April.

Marriages decreased for all three time periods shown below. For the 12 months ending with April, marriages decreased by 1.3 percent.

Dissolutions of marriage also decreased for all three time periods. For the 12 month period ending with April, the marriage to divorce ratio increased from 1.80 to 1.82.

Infant deaths decreased for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with April, the infant death rate decreased from 7.5 to 7.1 per 1,000 live births.
