Provisional Vital Statistics for July 2008

Live births decreased in July as 7,133 Missouri babies were born compared with 7,376 in July 2007. Births also decreased for the cumulative 7-and 12-month periods ending with July.

Deaths decreased in July, but increased for the cumulative 7- and 12-month periods ending with July. For January-July, deaths increased by 5.9 percent from 31,827 to 33,692.

The **Natural increase** in July was 2,853 (7,133 minus 4,280 deaths). The natural increase declined sharply for the cumulative 7- and 12-month periods ending with July.

Marriages decreased for all three time periods shown below. For the 12 months ending with July, marriages decreased by 4.8 percent from 40,192 to 38,281.

Dissolutions of marriage decreased for the 7and 12-month periods ending with July. For the 12 months ending with July, the marriage to divorce ratio decreased from 1.80 to 1.75.

Infant deaths decreased for all three time periods shown below. For the 12 months ending with July, the infant death rate decreased from 7.6 to 6.9 per 1,000 live births.
