Provisional Vital Statistics for May 2008

Live births decreased slightly in May as 6,712 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,803 in May 2007. However, cumulative births for the 5- and 12-month periods ending with May both increased.

Deaths increased for all three time periods shown below. For the five months ending with May, deaths increased by 8.1 percent from 23,344 to 25,225.

The **Natural increase** in May was 2,265 (6,712 births minus 4,447 deaths). The cumulative natural increases for the 5- and 12-month periods ending with May both decreased.

Marriages decreased for all three time periods shown below. For January-May, the decrease was 6.6 percent.

Dissolutions of marriage also decreased for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with May, the marriage to divorce ratio increased from 1.78 to 1.82.

Infant deaths decreased for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with May, the infant death rate decreased from 7.6 to 7.1 per 1,000 live births.

The infant death rate is based on the number of infant deaths per 1000 live births. Beginning with provisional July 2006 data numbers and rates are based on month of event rather than month of report. This will result in a delay in reporting, but will more accurately reflect current trends.
