Provisional Vital Statistics for November 2008

Live births decreased in November as 5,965 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,633 one year earlier. Cumulative births for the 11- and 12-month periods ending with November also decreased. For January-November, births decreased by 1.5 percent.

Deaths increased for all three time periods shown below. For January-November deaths increased by 4.1 percent from 49,123 to 51,137.

The **Natural increase** in November was 1,532 (5,965 births minus 4,433 deaths). With the decrease in births and increase in deaths, the natural increase declined by 12.1 percent for January-November.

Marriages increased in November, but decreased for the cumulative 11- and 12-month periods ending with November.

Dissolutions of marriage decreased for all three time periods shown below. For the 12 months ending with November, the marriage to divorce ratio increased from 1.80 to 1.85.

Infant deaths decreased for all three time periods. For January-November, the infant death rate decreased from 7.6 to 6.9 per 1,000 live births.
