Provisional Vital Statistics for April 2009

Live births decreased in April as 6,385 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,595 one year earlier. Cumulative births for the 4- and 12-month periods ending with April also decreased. For January-April, births decreased by 5.4 percent.

Deaths decreased for all three time periods shown below. For January-April, deaths decreased by 12.7 percent from 20,954 to 18,289.

The **Natural increase** in April was 2,009 (6,385 births minus 4,376 deaths). The natural increase rose for January-April, but decreased for the 12 months ending with April.

Marriages decreased slightly in April as 2,661 Missouri couples married compared with 2,843 in April 2008. For the cumulative 4- and 12- months ending with April, marriages showed little or no change.

Dissolutions of marriage decreased slightly for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with April, the marriage to divorce ratio increased from 1.82 to 1.83.

Infant deaths decreased for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with April, the infant death rate decreased from 7.3 to 6.8 per 1,000 live births.
