Provisional Vital Statistics for August 2009

Live births decreased in August as 6,518 Missouri babies were born compared with 7,204 one year earlier. Cumulative 8- and 12- month periods also show rather large decreases in births. For January-August, births decreased by 5.5 percent from 54,438 to 51,422.

Deaths also decreased for all three time periods shown below. For January-August, deaths decreased by 6.8 percent from 38,159 to 35,563.

The **Natural increase** in August was 2,355 (6,518 births minus 4,163 deaths). For the cumulative 8- and 12- month periods ending with August, the natural increase declined.

Marriages decreased for all three time periods shown below. For January-August marriages decreased by 3.6 percent.

Dissolutions of marriage also decreased for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with August, the marriage to divorce ratio decreased from 1.84 to 1.81.

Continuing the pattern, **Infant deaths** also decreased for all three time periods shown below. For January-August, the infant death rate decreased from 7.2 to 6.8 per 1,000 live births.

The infant death rate is based on the number of infant deaths per 1000 live births. Beginning with provisional July 2006 data numbers and rates are based on month of event rather than month of report. This will result in a delay in reporting, but will more accurately reflect current trends.
