Provisional Vital Statistics for December 2009

Live births decreased in December as 6,411 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,707 one year earlier. Cumulative births for the 12 months ending with December decreased by 3 percent. The crude 2009 provisional birth rate of 13.1 per 1,000 population represents a record low.

Deaths decreased by 4.5 percent for the 12 months ending with December from 56,278 to 53,757. The crude 2009 death rate of 9.0 per 1,000 population is also a record low rate.

The **Natural increase** in December was 1,686 (6,411 births minus 4,725 deaths). With a similar drop in births and deaths, the natural increase showed little change between 2008 and 2009.

Marriages decreased in December and for the 12 months ending with December. While there are some late reporting counties, it appears that marriages will drop below 40,000 for the first time since 1965.

Dissolutions of marriage increased slightly in 2009. For the 12 months ending with December, the marriage to divorce ratio decreased from 1.81 to 1.75.

Infant deaths decreased in December and for the 12 months ending with December. The provisional 2009 infant death rate of 7.1 per 1,000 live births would be a record low rate if it holds through finalization.
