## **Provisional Vital Statistics for March 2010**

**Live births** decreased slightly in March as 6,555 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,582 one year earlier. Cumulative births for the 3- and 12- month periods ending with March also decreased.

**Deaths** increased slightly for all three time periods shown below. However, for the 12 months ending with March, the death rate actually decreased because of the population increase.

The **Natural increase** for March was 1,633 (6,555 births minus 4,922 deaths). The natural increase rose for all three time periods.

**Marriages** decreased for all three time periods. In the 12 months ending with March, marriages decreased by 5.2 percent.

**Dissolutions of marriage** show little change from 2009 to 2010. However, with the decrease in marriages, the marriage to divorce ratio for the 12 months ending with March decreased from 1.82 to 1.71.

**Infant deaths** increased slightly for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with March, the infant death rate increased from 7.0 to 7.3 per 1,000 live births.
