Provisional Vital Statistics for May 2010

Live births decreased in May as 6,346 Missouri babies were born compared with 6,470 one year earlier. Cumulative births also decreased for the 5-and 12-month periods ending with May. For January-May, births decreased by 2.3 percent.

Deaths decreased in May, but increased slightly for the 5- and 12-month periods ending with May. For January-May, deaths increased from 23,212 to 23,390.

The **Natural increase** in May was 1,917 (6,346 births minus 4,429 deaths). The natural increase declined for all three time periods shown below.

Marriages decreased for all three time periods. For January-May, marriages decreased by 5.3 percent.

Dissolutions of marriage increased for all three time periods. For the 12 months ending with May, the marriage to divorce ratio decreased from 1.82 to 1.68.

Infant deaths decreased for all three time periods. For January-May, the infant death ratio decreased from 7.6 to 7.2 per 1,000 live births.
