As of November 1, 2012, ProQuad, a combination of the Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Varicella vaccine (MMRV) will be available to order through the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program.

The attached Vaccine Accountability Form, Pediatric Order Form, Vaccine Transfer and Tally Sheet have been changed to reflect this addition. These forms can also be found at <u>health.mo.gov/living/wellness/immunizations/providerforms.php</u>.

Please note that ProQuad must be stored in the freezer.
